The Junior Clinical Training Scholarship in pig health management provides an opportunity for new or recently qualified veterinary graduates to obtain post-graduate training in this specialty in preparation for Senior Clinical Training Scholarship programmes (residencies), or for work in specialist farm animal practice. The program is jointly managed by The University of Cambridge and BQP (part of Tulip Ltd), a growing organisation based in Stradbroke, Suffolk, with over 50,000 breeding sows, taking progeny through to slaughter with down stream processing managed by the parent company, Tulip UK.

The programme includes practical clinical experience in all aspects of pig health and production, preventive herd health management programs, experience in teaching clinical students and the opportunity for involvement in research.
